² Students, in discussion with their mentor, select three of the following four core practica rotations (e.g., child, med/health, neuro, mental health, without the requirement of seeing psychotherapy cases (Clinical Science students do not take the Rural/Primary Care practicum).

³ Students take 2 credits per semester for the three semesters they are on internship.

⁴ Students take a minimum of 1 credit in F, S, and Su of the first year and 1 credit in F of the second year. They then take 3 credits the S of their second year, when they defend their theses and are awarded the M.S. degree.

⁵ Minimum of 12 credits of CLP 7980 are required.

⁶ Specific coursework and advanced specialty practicum requirements vary by area and are set by the AOC faculty in Clinical Child/Pediatric Psychology, Neuropsychology, Neurorehabilitation, and Clinical Neuroscience, Clinical Health Psychology, and Emotion, Neuroscience and Psychopathology.

⁷ Advanced specialty practica must provide a minimum of 50 face-to-face contact hours of psychotherapy/intervention in the student's area of concentration or student must obtain the requisite intervention hours by registering for CLP 6947: Advanced Intervention Practicum (2 semesters; 1 credit) or therapy hours can be obtained through a combination of these.
